Nieuwe Testament Grieks

G3796 *opse*, ὀψέ late

From the same as *opiso* (through the idea of backwardness);
(adverbially) late in the day;
by extension, after the close of the day -- (at) even, in the end.

G3798 *opsios*, ὀπιος, ὀψία, ὀπιον (ὀψέ) evening

From *opse*; late; feminine (as noun) afternoon (early eve)
or nightfall (later eve) -- even(-ing, (-tide)).
